<u>General picture of dog:</u> This is a typical young female Drent. She is well-proportioned with lean muscle. Coat and furnishings are thin, but will likely develop with age. Overall, an excellent example of the breed standard.

<u>Head (including color and shape of the eyes, ears, teeth and pigmentation):</u> Good head shape with wedge-shaped muzzle. Ears are well set and appropriate in length. Good eye set and color that matches the coat color. Good scissor bite. Lips are tight.

Body (including assessment front and rear, the top and bottom lines and tail): Good, strong neck. Throat folds are present. Chest appropriate depth with sufficient forechest. Correct front assembly and back end angulation. Slightly long in the back. Straight forelegs and rear legs. Tail set is slightly low, but within the normal range. Appropriate tail length. Croup is slightly rounded. Deviations from the breed standard in this category are minor and not expected to affect the movement or athleticism of the dog. The structure and muscle on this dog are next to ideal for a hunting Drent.

<u>Hair:</u> Nice coat with appropriate texture and markings. Much more white than brown. Placement and color of markings are appropriate. Foreleg furnishings need development. However, for a bitch of her age her chest and hind leg furnishings are good. However, this is a young dog and these will more than likely develop.

Movement: Very nice gait. Harmonious movement that drives from the rear.
